



In the final term of the last school year, both Grade 4 (current Grade 5) and 6 students participated in the Cambridge KET and Flyers exams. The 2023-24 year marked the introduction of voluntary assessments, and the response from both parents and students was positive. Our dedicated teachers invested significant time and effort to prepare the students for these examinations, and their hard work paid off with impressive results.

Among the Grade 4 Flyers participants, 70% achieved perfect scores and distinctions, earning the maximum of 15 shields. Similarly, 60% of the Grade 6 KET participants also secured perfect scores and distinctions with A grades. As we have moved into the 2024-25

school year, our focus has shifted entirely to the KET examination for our Grade 6 students. The enthusiasm for participation has continued to gain considerable interest, reflecting our community's commitment to academic excellence.

Looking ahead, we are excited about the potential for our students to continue excelling in their English language skills. With strong support from our teachers and the GT community, we are optimistic that this trend of success will continue, paving the way for even greater achievements in the future.
