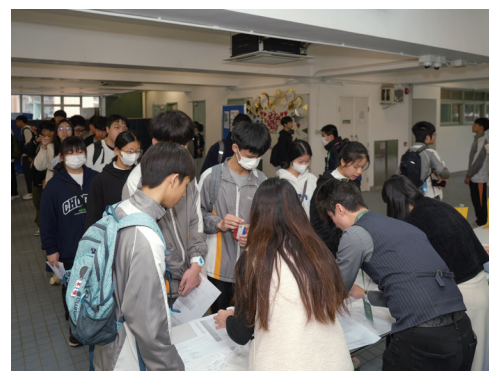
The Turkic International Mathematical Olympiad (TIMO) is one of the most prestigious mathematics competitions in the world, organized by the Global Olympiad Center. Taking place in Hong Kong and organized by the Gifted Education Council, the HKTIMO 2025 served as the selection event for the Turkic International Mathematical Olympiad. G.T. (Ellen Yeung) College was designated as the official competition venue, hosting over 300 participants from various schools in a highly competitive environment.

After the conclusion of the HKTIMO 2025 competition, the atmosphere was electric with excitement. This year, 67 schools participated, with the top 10% of exceptional students earning a place on the Hong Kong Team, which will travel to Antalya, Turkey, for the Global Round in mid-April. Among the team members, 26 students came from G.T. College, while 9 represented other schools, highlighting the diversity and excellence of this competition. These talented individuals will compete alongside elite participants from 35 countries, including Japan, South Korea, and Singapore, showcasing their skills on the international stage.

在剛結束的「九龍東VEX機械人挑戰賽」中，本校學生表現出色，展現了卓越的工程能力與團隊精神。同學們運用上百種VEXIQ零件，親手組裝、編程機械人，並在工程日誌中詳細記錄研發過程。在比賽中，同學們能與其他隊伍即時討論策略，互相合作，更是難能可貴。

五、六年級隊伍吸收過往兩次VEXIQ賽事經驗，持續優化機械結構、提升射擊命中率，最終成功晉級決賽。四年級隊伍主動研究其他學校VEXIQ設計方案，開發出獨創的機械結構，儘管未能晉身決賽，評判高度肯定他們的機械結構和創意，獲大會頒發設計獎。

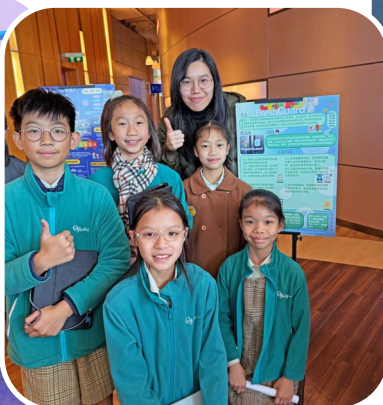
此次賽事提升了學生的編程邏輯、機械工程與臨場問題解決能力，期待同學們在未來賽事中再創佳績！

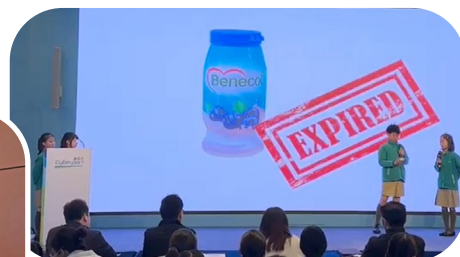

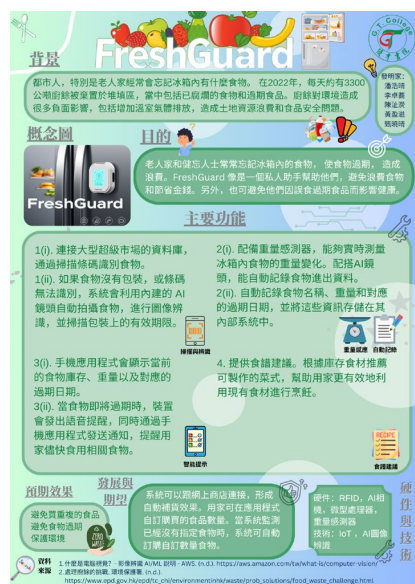
他們的發明品是「FreshGuard」。概念源於他們發現都市人，尤其是老人家經常會忘記冰箱內有甚麼食物，以致食物過期，造成廚餘和浪費金

錢。他們希望發明一個裝置放在冰箱外側，內置AI鏡頭和微型處理器。利用AI圖像識別技術，自動記錄冰箱內食物的過期日，並透過App讓用戶接收食物到期日訊息提醒、庫存管理和食譜建議等，幫助用戶減少食物浪費。同學們能夠發現日常生活中的問題，並活用創意和知識解決難題，值得欣賞，期望他們的作品有機會早日實現！
