It was our great honor to have Professor Joseph Sung Jao-Yiu, Senior Vice President (Health & Life Sciences), Dean, Lee Kong Chian School of Medicine, Distinguished University Professor in Nanyang Technological University, Singapore and the 7th President of The Chinese University of Hong Kong to share his insights in a sharing talk on 30 May 2025. Prof. Sung gave a talk entitled “Is medicine a Science or an Art” in which he shared the impact of Artificial Intelligence (AI) in medicine. He mentioned that generative AI may improve diagnosing assistant by interpreting data and providing in-depth insights for the patient. However, AI cannot fully replace humanity. AI can augment human capabilities and automate some tasks, but it lacks essential human qualities like empathy and care, which are important to strengthen the patient-physician relationship, building patient trust and ultimately resulting in better health outcomes. In the Q&A session, he recounted his path to leadership, which was paved by his formidable interpersonal skills, enabling him to navigate complex dynamics and inspire others. 50 parents and 4 G.T. alumni currently pursuing medicine attended this special assembly.

Hong Kong, May 17, 2025 – G.T. College co-hosted the much-anticipated "2025 Voice To The World" National Speaking Competition (Hong Kong Region) alongside the Gifted Education Council (GEC). The full-day event, running from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm, drew an impressive 282 registered students from 40 diverse schools across Hong Kong, ranging from kindergarten to secondary levels, all eager to showcase their impromptu speaking and persuasive communication skills.

Secondary school students also tackled the "Elevator Pitch," where they had a mere 30 seconds to present a compelling idea after brief preparation, followed by an intense minute of questioning, pushing their ability to articulate their ideas clearly under pressure.

The event was met with great enthusiasm, creating a positive and engaging atmosphere throughout the day. Many parents attended to support their children and witness their impressive performances, appreciating the opportunity to see students shine and visit the G.T. campus. 開放教室是一項極具價值的教學交流活動，也是本校致力推行的項目之一。學校邀請一年級和四年級的家長走進校園，讓他們親身體驗孩子的學習過程，了解老師的教學方式與課堂互動，提升教學透明度與互動性，進一步促進家校合作，共同營造優質的學習環境。

本年度的開放教室活動於3月26日、3月28日(將軍澳校舍)及4月1日、4月3日(旺角校舍)順利進行，短短四天，吸引了二百多位家長踴躍參與，校園裏充滿了溫馨的互動與歡笑。衷心感謝家長們在課堂上細心觀察孩子的學習情況，用心地填寫了問卷，分享寶貴的感受和意見。家長們對老師教學的肯定與讚賞，既是對我們的鼓勵，也是推動我們持續提升教學質素的重要動力。

在問卷中，99.41%的家長認為老師能以愛心關懷學生，經常給予鼓勵和讚美，營造出輕鬆愉快的課堂氛圍；98.39%的家長贊同老師的教學內容和活動創意十足，切合學生的需求和能力，達到了預設的教學目標；98.14%的家長認為學生上課時能專心致志，遵守紀律，並積極參與學習。這可見老師在教學時都能秉持學校的三大宗旨——「愛心、創意、勤奮」，並深受家長認同。近年，學校積極推動的電子學習，老師在課堂上加入豐富的電子教學元素，旨在提升教學效果，增強學生的自主學習能力，在問卷中，98.22%的家長均認同電子工具能有效輔助教學，效果十分理想。

觀課結束後，學校特別安排分享會，讓家長與校長及老師交流，分享心得，很多家長皆認為，透過這次活動，他們更能理解學校的教學理念，並感受到老師的細心指導。在此，感謝你們對學校與老師的認同與讚賞，感謝你們以感謝卡傳遞的真摯謝意，讓我們繼續攜手培育學生成長，為孩子的教育旅程添上更多精彩篇章。
