September 26<sup>th</sup> is celebrated annually as the European Day of Languages—a day dedicated to promoting the benefits of language learning, breaking down cultural barriers, fostering international friendships, and creating broader opportunities for future careers.

To mark this meaningful occasion, the European Union Office to Hong Kong and Macao, together with the Alliance Française de Hong Kong, the Goethe-Institut Hong Kong, and several European consulates, jointly organized a “Speak Dating” event at Festival Walk in Kowloon Tong. Participants had the opportunity to experience multiple languages in a short period of time, with foreign teachers guiding them through simple games and quizzes to learn some useful greetings and expressions.

Twenty-four of our Grade 6 students actively participated in the event. They explored 12 European languages in groups, bravely speaking up amid laughter and applause, and won small prizes through interactive games. This memorable experience not only brought them joy in learning but also deepened their appreciation for the cultural significance of languages, inspiring greater motivation and enthusiasm for future language studies.

It was our great honor to have Prof. Philip Wai Yan Chiu, Dean of the Faculty of Medicine at The Chinese University of Hong Kong to share his insights in a sharing talk on 9 October 2025. Prof. Chiu gave a talk entitled “Medtech Innovation: From Personal Dream to Societal Impact”, in which he shared his life experience and the recent advance in the use of technology in medicine.

Prof. Chiu is a pioneer in robotic endoscopic surgery. He was passionate about science fiction when he was young, particularly Star Trek and Mobile Suit Gundam, which inspired him to devote himself to the research of robotic minimally invasive surgery. He also talked about the latest development in innovative medical devices and robotics which have the potential to improve surgical precision and procedure. Besides, he was exploring the potential application of nano-robots in clinical fields. In the Q&A session, he shared valuable insights that the existence of death makes life meaningful. He expressed that we should enjoy the scenery along the way. The special assembly was also attended by five G.T. alumni who are currently pursuing medicine.
